Children learn in a variety of ways. Our spelling homework has been designed to provide both active and written tasks. Children must choose 4 activities per week to practise their spelling words. Please date and initial the completed activities in the boxes provided.



These activities could also be used to practise your phonics words.

Write each of your words in rainbow colours.

   

Write 5 words, draw pictures to show each word's meaning.

   

Type your words on the computer and print them out.

   

Spell your words aloud. Pass a ball to a partner for every letter.

   

Give someone at home a spelling test with your words. Mark it to check if they are correct.

   

Spell your words aloud. Stand up for every vowel, sit down for every consonant.

   

Choose 4 words and write silly sentences.

   

Write your words in bubble writing.

   

Draw a fairytale picture. Hide 6 of your words in the picture.

   

Look for some of your words in a storybook.

   

Ask a family member to time you spelling your words aloud.

   

Draw a pirate ship. Hide 6 of your words in the picture.

   

Write your words in dot-to-dot letters. Join them up with a coloured pencil.

   

Count the number of letters in each word. Write the words in order from shortest to longest.

   

Spell your words aloud. Do star jumps for each letter.

   

Trace your spelling words in the air. Ask a family member to guess each word.
